

6th Grade Expectations, Consequences, & Rewards

Expectations: To insure a great learning environment, students must:

1. Be on time.
2. Be prepared for class with all necessary materials and assignments.
3. Be respectful of the rights and properties of others.
4. Be polite and practice self-control.
5. Be a team player to have fun!

Consequences: Failing to meet any of the expectations will result in a penalty mark.

1. Everyone makes a mistake and that's why the first mark is considered a warning.
2. Accumulating 2 marks in ALL classes, results in an individual meeting with the teacher assigning it to discuss an improvement plan.
3. Accumulating 3 marks in ALL classes, results in both a meeting with the team teachers and a phone call/email notifying parents to develop solutions. This may include a parent-teacher conference.
4. Accumulating 4 marks in ALL classes, results in an office referral to meet with a principal.

Important to Note:

- Obviously, some behaviors will result in automatic office referral.
- Marks will accumulate for ALL classes, so students' marks could add up quickly. The goal is to try to change your behavior after a mark to prevent further consequences.
- The slate is wiped clean each grading period.

Rewards: Something given for your effort and achievement.

6. Unused Mark Slips will count as bonus
